

## **ENHANCED DRIVER'S LICENSE PROGRAM**



In general, EDLs will have the following safeguards, regardless of issuing state or province:



- 1 The seal of the issuing state or province.\*
- <sup>(2)</sup> Unique identification number.
- ③ Metallic flag.\*
- ④ Second faded picture.\*
- 5 The word "Enhanced" will appear at the top of the license.\*
- 6 All EDLs will also have a Machine Readable Zone on the back.
- \*some variations will exist, including specific placement
