All non-immigrant visa and other requirements imposed by U.S. law are still applicable.

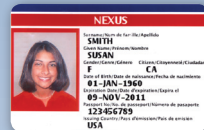
United States Citizens require one of the following:

Enhanced Driver's License
*when and where available



NEXUS Card



FAST Card



SENTRI Card



Military ID Card with orders



U.S. Merchant Mariner Card in conjunction with official maritime business

OR

Two-document option denoting citizenship and identity. Please see the CBP tear sheet for complete details. This option is only valid until June 1, 2009.

Canadian/Bermudian Citizen Visitors require one of the following:



Passport



NEXUS Card



SENTRI Card



FAST Card



Enhanced Driver's License

OR

Two-document option denoting citizenship and identity. Please see the CBP tear sheet for complete details. This option is only valid until June 1, 2009.

U.S. and Canadian Native Americans require one of the following:



INAC Card



Native American Tribal Photo Identification Card

The American Indian Card (Form I-872) is also acceptable, or any of the applicable documents listed in the U.S. or Canadian sections.

Mexican Citizen Visitors require the following:



Passport and Visa



Border Crossing Card

Mexican SENTRI or FAST program members must also present one of the above.

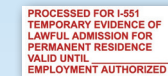
Lawful Permanent Residents require one of the following:

ADIT Stamp

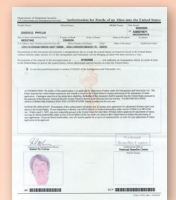
All Others require one of the following:

(Re-entry Permit/Refugee Travel Document)



Parole Letter



Transportation Letter

*As of June 1, 2009 U.S. & Canadian citizens under the age of 16 (or 19, if traveling with a designated group) may present a birth certificate, Consular Report of Birth Abroad, Canadian Citizenship Card, or a naturalization certificate. Until that date, all children ages 18 and under need only present proof of citizenship.
